



## About Varosha

An emblematic site of displacement and contested heritage. Once a thriving coastal district of Famagusta, Cyprus, it was abandoned and sealed off following the 1974 conflict. Today, it stands as a potent symbol of urban rupture, memory loss, and geopolitical stasis.





Physically inaccessible to the public, except for two reopened streets under surveillance since 2020. The area remains under the control of the Turkish military, with restricted access and no permanent civilian return permitted.

Digital platforms shape memory through algorithmic timelines and curated visibility.

Drawing on digital ethnography in Varosha, Cyprus, this research reframes contested heritage as a dynamic, data-driven archive, formed through interfaces, affect, and temporal triggers.
